And forgive us our trespasses,

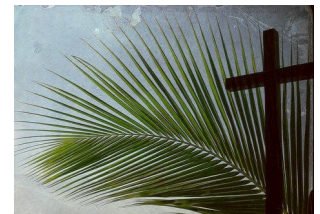
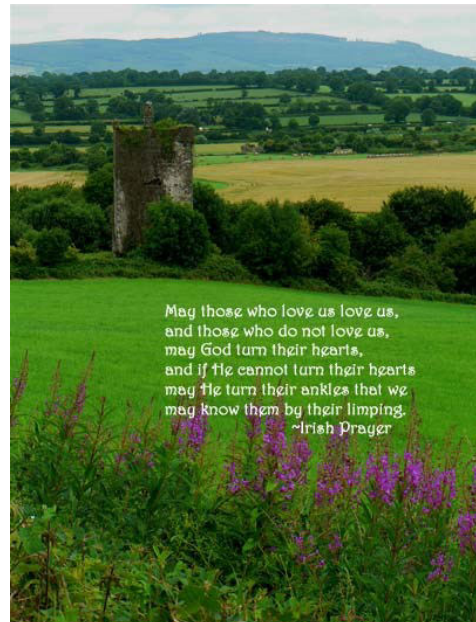
As we forgive those
