


TAKE A MOMENT:

Jesus, I believe in You and in Your promises. Give me the strength to live my life as a reflection of You and the courage to respond to doubt and fear with confidence and











THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS SEPT 14



TTH FEAST OF THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS CELEBRATES TWO HISTORICAL EVENTS: THE DISCOVERY OF THE TRUE CROSS BY ST. HELENA, THE MOTHER OF THE EMPEROR CONSTANTINE, IN 320 UNDER THE TEMPLE OF VENUS IN JERUSALEM, AND THE DEDICATION IN 335 OF THE BASILICA AND SHRINE BUILT ON CALVARY BY CONSTANTINE, WHICH MARK THE SITE OF THE CRUCIFIXION.

THE BASILICA, NAMED MARTYRIUM AND THE SHRINE, NAMED CALVARIUM, WERE DESTROYED BY THE PERSIANS IN 614. THE CHURCH OF THE HOLY SEPULCHER WHICH NOW STANDS ON THE SITE WAS BUILT BY THE CRUSADERS IN 1149.

THE FEAST IS A CELEBRATION AND COMMEMORATION OF GOD'S GREATEST WORK: HIS DEATH ON THE CROSS AND HIS RESSURECTION, THROUGH WHICH DEATH WAS DEFEATED AND THE DOORS TO HEAVEN OPENED.

THE ENTRANCE ANTIPHON FOR THE FEAST OF THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS IS: "WE SHOULD GLORY IN THE CROSS OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, FOR HE IS OUR SALVATION, OUR LIFE AND OUR RESURRECTION: THROUGH HIM WE ARE SAVED AND MADE FREE."
