



4 minutes:

Read the passage several times. (as many times as you can in 4 minutes)

JOHN 3:16

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.

Roman 5:8

But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.

1 John 4:9-10

God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. This is real love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins.

Think about the following questions and how they might apply your life.

6 minutes:

Spend six minutes talking to God. Here are some things to talk to him about.

1. Worship only makes sense in a relationship. We can only really worship God when we are in relationship with Him. Ask God to help you feel His love in a new, personal, amazing, intimate way.
2. What do you think are some of the things that get in the way of feeling God's presence? It could be stress from school, a job, your family. It could be pain from someone who has hurt you. It could be bitterness and resentment. Ask Him for help in these obstacles.
3. Read John 3:16 again. Ask God to make some part of those verse stand out in a new way for you.
4. Spend at least one minute being completely quiet. During this time tell God you want to hear whatever it is He wants to say. He may speak to you or He may not, the point is that you listened!
5. Ask God to help you share His love with others today.
