














Dear Parishioners,



THE LSEC CORNER

How does one express a concern directly to an individual who whether, unknowingly or knowingly, doesn't fully implement the **Protecting God's Children** (PGC) principles? PGC is a prevention and awareness training at the parish level for adults. The focus is on identifying ways to implement a safe environment for children and vulnerable adults.

When one sees a situation that causes unease, several questions naturally follow: "What should I do?" "How do I approach the person?" What should I say?"

Through the PGC Program, we learn that by speaking with someone, we are "not accusing someone of being a child abuser, we are simply pointing out something of concern."

Those of us engaged in the Church's many forms of ministry must be willing to express concerns. We must also be open to feedback from others. It is important for us to view our actions through others' eyes. When we are willing to make changes, we, too, create an environment where the warning signs of a potential abusers become obvious, thus we become even stronger protectors of children.

You can register for a PGC class at www.virtus.org. If this is your first time taking PGC, some classes are offered virtually. All volunteers that work with children are required to complete PGC, have a background check and complete a volunteer application. PGC certification is valid for five years.
