Music Ministry Minutes

“He who sings, prays twice”

During the past 14 months, the Pandemic has brought a lot of changes to our lives. Thanks to our Archdiocese and to our pastor, Msgr. Hynes, the celebrating of mass here at OLBS has never stopped, adapting to rules and restrictions through technology!

The Music Ministry is one that stayed active through the closure of the church, providing music when the recorded masses were the only ones allowed and then continuing when live masses were finally allowed again. Cantors, or Leaders of Song, now sing upstairs, during masses and funerals. Our Adult and Youth Choirs have met virtually through Zoom and in outdoor and safely spaced indoor situations to record music for the seasons, most recently for Lent and Easter.

Here at OLBS, our Music Ministry does not function alone: it is consistently working together with other ministries, as with the Religious Ed Ministry in helping enhance the sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation with music during those celebrations. Whether with our new Spiritual Concerns Ministry in helping provide music for the Friday Exposition, Benediction and Adoration services during Lent or the Chaplet on Divine Mercy Sunday, or with the OLBS Youth Group, presenting their recorded version of the Stations of the Cross, including a beautiful song with piano and sung by Youth Group members Luciana Musano and Gabrielle Romano.

As the weeks go by and as things improve, we pray, you will continue to see and hear our Music Ministry members during mass and at other times we gather as a church community, and there will be more and more collaboration between our ministries here to help share the word of God and carry out our mission to serve God and each other.
