This weekend, our parishioners have viewed a video in which Cardinal Tobin spoke about this year's appeal *Shining the Light of Christ*. The video showed only a few of the ways in which the annual appeal supports the mission and the ministries of the Archdiocese of Newark. There are simply too many to highlight on the video without taking an extraordinarily long time. The video's purpose is simply to shows that the money raised by the appeal is used in a variety of ways for the proclamation of the Gospel.

We so often think of that proclamation as taking place from a pulpit or in a classroom. That is most definitely one of the ways in which the Gospel message is passed on. However, the word is God is equally announced by the actions in which we participate. And so, we saw how Catholic Charities seeks to develop ways to ensure that those with disabilities always know that they have a place in our worship. Those who have come to our country from other nations are given the legal help that they require to ultimately become naturalized citizens in this nation. The Office of Respect Life provides what is necessary, especially clothing and food, so that people can have the dignity that is their right as children of God. For those who believe that they have a vocation to a life of service as a priest of the archdiocese, programs are offered to assist them in their discernment as to where the Lord is leading them. The Office of Youth and Young Adult, among other ministries, offers children the chance to enjoy activities in summer camps that they sponsor.

As I mentioned at the start of this column that what you viewed on the video only scratches the surface of the many programs that the Archdiocese of Newark offers through the various offices and agencies that are the instrument for fulfilling what we are called to do and to be as the local Church of Newark.

I know that not everyone is able to offer the same amount. However, each donation gives the archdiocese another tool to offer the programs and the assistance needed so that we can *Shine the Light of Christ.* Please consider being one of the ways through which that light can shine so that we, as a local Church, can fulfill our mission.

You have noticed the wooden frame that is at the base of the baptismal font that has been returned to the church. That frame will soon be waterproofed and covered with marble and will become the lower font where, we hope, adults will soon be baptized into the family of God which is the Church. Our font will then have two parts to it: the upper font for infant baptisms and the lower font for adult baptisms. As a sign that the waters of baptism will bring new life to those being initiated, the water of the font will not be still. It will flow from the upper font to the lower font as a sign that the water will bring the life of Christ to those who are baptized.

The contractor has assured me that the font will be completed by the end of January. We can then invite those asking to be initiated into the Body of Christ to come to the water of new life.


