## **Secrets vs Surprises**

Let children know there are not secrets when it comes to personal and physical safety. That, it is wrong for an adult or another child to ask to keep a secret about safety – especially unsafe touches – because that is a way for people to get hurt. If an individual tries to make a child keep a secret or frightens them, children must know the right thing to do is immediately talk to a safe adult or parent. Reassure the child that he/she will be protected regardless of any threats or seeming consequences of "telling." When a child knows the difference between secrets and surprises and that keeping a secret is not ok, he/she is more likely to reveal boundary violations.
