# **Online Safety**

Just as caring adults have a responsibility to keep kids safe

as they learn to cross the street, we have a responsibility to keep them safe as they begin to navigate virtual learning online. For older children, this may involve monitoring the various social networking sites or learning to decipher instant-messaging shorthand. For the youngest user, however, the guidelines are more basic but just as important.

- Monitor the monitor young users should never be online alone. Adults need to be accessible to help guide their searches or to quickly close an unexpected site.
- **Centrally locate the computer** by putting the computer in the kitchen or a family room, allows an adult the opportunity to monitor the online work.
- Make sure all caregivers know the basicspost an outline so the caregiver and the child can see the rules for being online.
- **Communicate** children need to know why you are being vigilant as they work online. Explain that not everyone or everything maybe as it appears.
