Fr. Stefano's reflection on Pentecost Sunday (May 31st, 2020)

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

I meditated on the Holy Spirit to prepare my homily for Pentecost Sunday with this GPS navigation device. I think that the Holy Spirit is similar to a GPS Navigator. Usually we put our destination address into a GPS. For example, we can put the address for Fairchilds Market, 171 Eagle Rock Avenue, Roseland, New Jersey and zip code 07068. Then it itself begins to operate and lead us to our final destination with a gentle voice. "Turn right! Turn left! In 500 feet, there is Fairchilds Market, your favorite one," like this. However, sometimes we drive the wrong way and just at the moment the Navigator begins to recalculate and guide us on the right path again. This is the role of the GPS Navigator, to guide us in the right path, always.

In the same vein, the Holy Spirit leads us to see God, our Father. The Holy Spirit is the spiritual GPS Navigator for us. The Holy Spirit helps us to become children of God, and helps us to escape from the slavery of sin. The Holy Spirit inspires us to say, "Abba, Father!"

Moreover, the Spirit bears witness that we are children of God. We are heirs of God with Christ. Therefore we may suffer with Christ to glorify His sacrifice and his love through the help of the Holy Spirit. (cf. Romans 8:14-17)

The Holy Spirit is so patient and faithful. If we go on the wrong path, he always leads us back to the right way like a GPS, the way of true love which unites the Trinity; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit with us. This is because God wants to share a special love with us eternally in the divine love of the Most Holy Trinity.

However, there is a difference between a GPS Navigator and the Holy Spirit. The GPS Navigator can be turned off when the power goes out. But we cannot turn off God's Navigation system because the Holy Spirit is located in our hearts until we die. Maybe God's Navigator, the Spirit of God cannot be turned off because the owner of the switch is God, the enteral Father.

Today we celebrate the feast of Pentecost Sunday. Pentecost marks the end and the goal of the Easter season. For Christians, it is a memorial of the day the Holy Spirit descended on the apostles and the Virgin Mary in the form of fiery tongues, an event that took place fifty days after the Resurrection of Jesus. The feast also commemorates the official inauguration of the Christian Church by the apostolic preaching of St. Peter, which resulted in the conversion of 3000 Jews to the Christian Faith. Pentecost is, thus, the official birthday of the Church. So today is the birthday of the Church! We are truly blessed to celebrate this wonderful feast! By giving the gift of the Holy Spirit, the Lord calls us to great things... to ministry, charity and holiness in his own name. The Lord breathes the Holy Spirit upon the Church and on you and me so that all we are and all we do might be touched by his mighty hand.

In today's Sequence, the Church repeats her prayer of invitation to the Holy Spirit to come to us all now and details the effects His presence and His gifts will have on all of us, if we choose to receive them through the Holy Spirit who is God's GPS.
