

Sunday June 19 Readings

Reading I: Genesis 14: 18-20

Melchizedek, the king of Salem (peace) and priest of God most high, gives a blessing to Abram by offering bread and wine to the Lord.

Reading II: I Corinthians 11: 23-26

Paul passes on to his readers what he had received from the Lord. We recognize that Jesus fulfills Melchizedek's offering here by giving us His Body and Blood under the forms of bread and wine.

The Gospel: Luke 9: 11b-17

Jesus had no difficulty feeding the hungry crowd of at least ten thousand people with five loaves and two fish. Clearly a harbinger of the Holy Eucharist, whereby He would feed the world.

Music Ministry Minutes

You might have noticed a change in the singing of "Gloria" this past weekend during Mass: there weren't as many repeats of the refrain for the congregation to sing! Some years ago, church composers took the "Gloria" prayer that was recited or chanted at Mass and changed it to a musical format with refrains and verses. This type of "Gloria" presentation is what we have been singing here at OLBS, until this past weekend. After discussions with Msgr. Hynes, it was decided that from now on, the cantor will introduce the "Gloria" refrain. which the congregation then repeats, with the remainder of the prayer sung straight through as it is written, with no insertions of the refrain until the very end, when we will sing the "Gloria" refrain once more. The cantor will no longer be singing the bulk of the prayer alone, as the congregation is encouraged to sing the entire prayer along with the cantor, as you would if you were reciting the "Gloria." Mission Appeal 2022 (Archdiocese of Imphal, India) Weekend of June 25/26

The mission Diocese of Imphal in Northeast India is home to 34 tribes of Mongolian origin. The first Catholic baptism in the diocese was recorded in 1952. The Catholic population has grown up to 1, 01283 now. The diocese has 45 parishes, and 8 Mission Centers, 174 priests including 114 indigenous tribal priests. The growth of the Church has always been accompanied by various challenges and persecutions during the past decades. Between 1990 - 2001, six of our young and dynamic missionaries were killed for witnessing the gospel.

Besides direct evangelization, the Church is actively involved in the everyday life of the people through other forms of apostolate like education, health care, self-help program, rehabilitation of the sick, drug addicts and the orphans. Much remains to be done for this interior and underdeveloped region through your participation and generous support.


In spite of the many challenges, missionary efforts are yielding an increase in vocation to priesthood and religious life. The proceeds of the 2022 Mission appeal will be used for providing food, safe drinking water facilities, primary education of tribal girls and health care for the rural tribal population in the newly established parish of St. John in Nungba.
