## *Catechesis Corner*

Our Faith Formation program is up and running and one of the main themes these opening weeks has been God’s creation of the world, from the Kindergarten class through the 8<sup>th</sup> grade classes. Our catechists have been using a variety of creative activities to share this lesson with our children, including the use of music, art, crafts and coloring and class time in the church and outside. It is during this season of Autumn it is especially easy to see and appreciate so much of God’s creation, in nature all around us. This is also a perfect time for you, our Faith Formation families, to find ways to observe together the beauty of the world around us. Remember, we are all part of God’s creation, so always plan time to do things together with each other, even though your days are crazy busy, and take a moment to soak in the magnificence of all that God has created. Time passes so quickly, our children grow up so fast, the time is now to be spontaneous or make plans to observe, enjoy and celebrate God’s creation, and, like God, you will see it is all very good, too!
