

## **Christmas Mass Attendance Guidelines for our Parish**

Celebrating Christmas, needless to say, will not be “normal” during the Covid-19 health crisis this year. We surely want to have a beautiful and solemn liturgical celebration, however, we must ensure the safety and wellbeing of all our parishioners, priests and staff. All of the directives from our Archdiocese ([www.rcan.org/covid19](http://www.rcan.org/covid19)) must be adhered to and the obligation to attend Mass remains suspended. Parishioners who feel vulnerable or at risk, should remain home and view Mass on-line or televised.

Our parish church capacity adhering to the guidelines is eighty-seven (87) persons. The requirement for social distancing and the proper wearing of masks is mandated.

Unfortunately, the news of a second wave in this pandemic is very troublesome and frightening. During the next few weeks, we will await any changes in the directives from the Archdiocese and amend our planning accordingly.
